Promotions (to be effective 7/1/14)

These numbers do not include the lecturers and clinical rank faculty dossiers which were considered by the Lecturer and Clinical Rank Faculty Promotion Committee.

34 dossiers were submitted; 34 candidates were approved; 0 candidates were not approved.

All dossiers were for full-time faculty:

To Professor - 14 applied, 14 were approved, 0 were not approved (3 female – 3 White approved; 11 male – 1 Asian approved, 1 Hispanic approved, 9 White approved)

To Associate Professor - 15 applied, 15 were approved, 0 were not approved (3 female – 1 Hispanic approved, 2 White approved; 12 male – 6 Asian approved, 1 Black approved, 1 Hispanic approved, 4 White approved)

To Senior Research Professor -1 applied, 1 was approved, 0 were not approved (1 male -1 Black approved)

To Associate Research Professor – 3 applied, 3 were approved, 0 were not approved (3 male – 1 Asian approved, 2 White approved)

To Professor (affiliate) -1 applied, 1 was approved, 0 were not approved (1 female -1 White approved)

In addition, 31 three-year review dossiers will be considered in March 2014. In March 2013, 31 three-year review dossiers were considered, of which the committee found 21 to be making adequate progress toward tenure and promotion and 10 to be lacking.
